Join this Innovation and Business Creation Summer School where participants will work in a creative and transformative learning environment that is designed around the practical and transferable skills necessary for successful innovation.

The Summer School will have 40 students going through a transformational experience in an action learning Summer School in two sites, [Trinity College Dublin](#) and [IESE Business School Barcelona](#).

Participants will learn about active and health ageing, real industry challenges and opportunities, the art of idea creation, the language of business and the basis of entrepreneurship and business plan development, including project management and entrepreneurial financing. Guest speakers (successful entrepreneurs, venture capitalists) will share and discuss their experiences, while a coach will work with participants to pitch their ideas. A selected set of participants' business plans will be presented to and reviewed by an expert audience.

The programme combines theoretical and practice based learning using real industry projects from the medical, health and technology sector. The Summer School is built around the key principles of multidisciplinary teamwork, action learning and strong mentoring.

At the end of the programme, participants will know how to transform creative ideas from their research into products, services and policies for advancing health, and for economic, social and cultural benefit.
